WHO IS JESUS?

1. Is He a ‘Lawbreaker?’ – 3:1-6

“Then he turned to his critics and asked, “Is it legal to do good deeds on the Sabbath, or is it a day for doing harm? Is this a day to save life or to destroy it?” But they wouldn’t answer him.” V. 4

2. Is He a ‘Miracle Worker?’ – 3:7-12

“The news about his miracles had spread far and wide, and vast numbers of people came to see him for themselves.” Vv. 7-8

3. Is He ‘Beside Himself?’ – 3:20-21, 31-35

“When Jesus returned to the house where he was staying, the crowds began to gather again, and soon he and his disciples couldn’t even find time to eat. When his family heard what was happening, they tried to take him home with them. “He’s out of his mind,” they said.” Mark 3:20-21 (NLT)

4. Is He ‘in League with Satan?’ – 3:22-30

“I assure you that any sin can be forgiven, including blasphemy; but anyone who blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will never be forgiven. It is an eternal sin.” He told them this because they were saying he had an evil spirit.” Vv. 28-30

5. Is He Your ‘Master?’ – 3:13-19

“Afterward Jesus went up on a mountain and called the ones he wanted to go with him. And they came to him. Then he selected twelve of them to be his regular companions, calling them apostles. He sent them out to preach, and he gave them authority to cast out demons. These are the names of the twelve he chose: Simon (he renamed him Peter), James and John (the sons of Zebedee, but Jesus nicknamed them “Sons of Thunder”), Andrew, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Thomas, James (son of Alphaeus), Thaddaeus, Simon (the Zealot), Judas Iscariot (who later betrayed him).” V. 13-19
